

Line

A continuous mark on a surface by a moving point. **Open** from the beginning to the ending.

* Outline, contour, silhouette.



Shape

A visual element that has two dimensions: length and width.

Closed.

*Square, triangle, circle, free-form.



Color

Properties of <u>hue</u> (red, blue, etc.), <u>intensity</u> (purity and strength of a color), and <u>value</u> (lightness or darkness).



Form

<u>Three-dimensional</u> (having height, width and depth) and which <u>encloses volume.</u>

* cubes, spheres, pyramids, and cylinders.



Texture

Surface Qualities. The **look or feel** of objects.

* rough, smooth, glassy, blurry, silky, wooly.



Value

Describes the <u>lightness or darkness</u> of a color. Gradual changes in drawings, woodcuts, photographs, etc. even when color is absent.



Space

<u>Two or three-dimensional</u> in reference to the distance or area <u>between, around, above, below or within</u> objects.
